

## **Book It Instructions**

Book It is optional in fourth grade. You are already reading 10 minutes a night for reading homework, so more isn't necessary. However, if you want to get the free pizza every month, you just need to read an additional 10 minutes a week.

You must read age-appropriate (or older) books. Magazines, comic books, optical illusion books, etc. do not count. They should be stories or reference books (books about oceans or animals, for example).

On the monthly logs, the last column tells you how many minutes must be read for that week. It will usually be 50 minutes (10 minutes each day for four days of homework, plus 10 minutes), but at the beginning and end of the month, when it's not a full week, it will be less (you'll make up the time at the beginning of the next month).

The number of minutes you read each day goes in the box that corresponds with the date. (Put the 10 minutes a day for the reading homework on Mondays through Thursdays.) Don't forget to put the total number of minutes at the end of every week.

It is due the first school day of the new month (due dates are on the top, near the parent signature). You need to write your name and fill out the sheet and your parent needs to sign it.
