A.) greater than: $>$

Hint: The open end is next to
the bigger #

B.) less than: $<$

(it wants to eat a big meal).

C.) equal to: $=$

Ex: $9 > 7$

$6 < 14$

$10 < 14$

$3 = 3$

With larger numbers, start at the left with the biggest place and
then compare each place, one at a time, moving to the right.

Ex: $125 < 132$ The hundreds place is the same,
so move to the tens place and compare them. The 3 is
bigger than the 2, so that means 132 is bigger than 125.

Ex: $665,543 > 665,534$
