

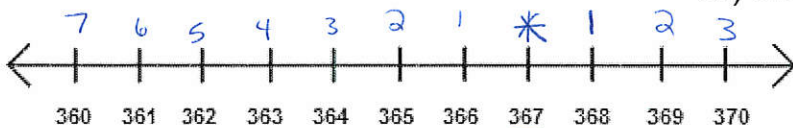

4th Grade Notes 1.5 Use Place Value to Round p. 37

- 1.) underline the number in the place you're rounding to
- 2.) draw an arrow to the number to the right of it
- 3.) that number tells you what to do:
 - A.) 5 or more, raise the score
(the number goes up by one)
 - B.) 4 or less, let it rest
(the number doesn't change)
- 4.) every number to the left of the place stays the same
- 5.) every number to the right of the place becomes zero

Ex: Round to the nearest tens

367 → 370

- 1.) underline the 6
- 2.) draw an arrow to the 7
- 3.) 7 tells you to go up
one so the
6 becomes 7
- 4.) the 7 becomes 0
- 5.) the 3 stays the same



closer to 370

Ex: Round to the thousands:

244,362 \rightarrow 244,000

Ex: Round to the tens:

196 \rightarrow 200

9 goes up one, which
means 9 becomes 10

so 196 becomes 200
