A.) Sum: the answer to an addition problem

B.) difference: the answer to a subtraction problem

C.) estimate: an answer close to the exact answer

- "Estimate" means round the numbers first, then solve

- "Round" means solve, then round the answer

- "About" means estimate

Ex: Estimate $2,342 + 637$
 $2,300 + 600 = 2,900$

(If they don't tell you what place to round, round to the highest place that both numbers have.)

Here, round to the nearest hundreds

Ex: Estimate $\$7,542 - \$3,230$
 $8,000 - 3,000 = \$5,000$
