4th Grade Notes 5.1 Multiply by Tens (Shortcut) p. 279

If there is a zero in the ones place in the second factor, you can multiply the second line: put down the zero and multiply the tens. (This is a shortcut and you need to do it whenever you can.)

Ex: 25

$$\begin{array}{r} 25 \\ \times 10 \\ \hline 00 \\ + 250 \\ \hline 250 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 45 \\ \times 90 \\ \hline 4,050 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 25 \\ \times 10 \\ \hline 250 \end{array}$$
