## Guidelines 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer Book Reports 2017-2018

*Due: the first day of school*

**You may write in your best handwriting (print or cursive) or the text can be typed on the computer. Please do everything on 8.5 X 11" paper, and do not put the reports in sheet protectors, folders, or report covers. Please don't staple the two reports together.**

**For one of your reports: Design a series of drawings that describe the main events in your book.**

1. State the title, the author, and main characters at the top of a page.
2. Then draw the most important events in order (like a cartoon; at least 4 events).
3. Write captions under each drawing explaining what you drew.
4. Somewhere else on your report paper, describe why you enjoyed or did not enjoy the book. Give details to explain your response.

**For the second report: Write a review of your book.**

Write a review of the book like you would read for a movie. Include:

- the title and the author
- a summary of the book: In about 5-8 sentences, tell what the story is about in the beginning, middle, and end. Include the setting and main characters.
- Say what is good about this book. Was anything not good?
- Say why someone should read this book. Give at least three reasons why with detail.
